It is also a great time to stop by the desk to ensure you are registered in the correct classes as we are starting recital plans, and we want to make sure the computer matches the classes you are taking as recital costumes will be ordered soon.



Recital Preparations Begin

Plans are beginning for our end of season recital. The first thing we do is collect recital costume fees. You may ask why this is the first thing we do. Well, all costumes are made to order, so before we can place an order for each class, we must have the costume fee collected from each student in that class. It also can take several months for costumes to arrive, so the earlier we order the more likely we are able to get the costume selected.

The tumbling and hip-hop classes are the only classes that do not have a costume fee due and that is because you will be responsible for getting those costumes on your own. Details regarding those class costumes will come closer to recital.

We will be measuring students in class to ensure the correct sizes are ordered. You will be responsible for minor alterations that can be resolved with a few stitches or safety pins. If major alterations are needed those will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.

For each class the costume fee is \$100.00. So, if your student is in both ballet and tap class you would owe \$200.00 as your costume fee. You can stop by the front desk at any time to pay your costume fee or if you have any questions.
